 - a. ASB President
 - i. LGBTQ+ collaborative promise meeting tomorrow night at 5pm. UM Pride and other groups are getting excited. Want to make sure they're having their voices heard. On Friday at 3pm, we have the Council for an Inclusive Community meeting. This is where all minority student organizations are invited to come and share ideas with ASB directly. Working to get a bus or method of transportation to get people from finals week to their cars from the library late at night starting at 1am. Will need more scantrons soon. We are working to put out some press releases for the merger with Safe Ride to get people excited about that time after midterms where people can have fun. Have transportation to get people from campus to the polls. Registration ended for elections and registered over 3,000 students to vote. Ole Miss Phenomena is coming up on October 25th. UM Family meeting on October 24th with BSU, NAACP, IFC, Panhellenic, NPHC, and ASB. Elections Task Force is going well.

 - i. October 9th, had an informal meeting and passed two resolutions through the Committee on Academics, titled Resolution 18-156 and 18-17. At senate last night, new legislative aide, Taylor Thompson, was sworn in for the Committee on Student Life. Resolution 18-16 was passed with unanimous consent. Resolution 18-17 was tabled right before senate by rules. It has now been passed for next week through the Committee on External Affairs.
