A BILL OF THE ASSOCIATED STUDENT BODY SENATE TO AMEND THE CONSTITUTION IN ACCORDANCE WITH ELECTION DATES STATED IN THE ASB CODE.

## ARTICLE III THE EXECUTIVE

SECTION 1. ESTABLISHMENT OF THE EXECUTIVE. The executive power of the ASB shall be vested in a President. The President and other elected ASB Executive Officers shall be chosen by the direct vote of the students in an election primary on the fourth Tuesday in March, for a term of one year beginning no later than one (1) month from the election primary. (Amended 2/19/2014)

SECTION 2. ELECTED OFFICERS. There shall be elected from among the students of The University of Mississippi the following Associated Student Body officers: (Amended 2/19/2014)

## ARTICLE III THE EXECUTIVE

SECTION 1. ESTABLISHMENT OF THE EXECUTIVE. The executive power of the ASB shall be vested in a President. The President and other elected ASB Executive Officers shall be chosen by the direct vote of the students in an election primary. The dates of the primary elections must be determined as prescribed by law. The term of one year beginning no later than one (1) month from the election primary. (amended 10/15/2015):

SECTION 2. ELECTED OFFICERS. There shall be elected from among the students of The University of Mississippi the following Associated Student Body officers: (Amended 2/19/2014)

WHEREAS, previous amendments made elections dates unclear;

WHEREAS, a clarification of suggested dates allows for more autonomy within the Attorney Generals power; AND

WHEREAS, this bill will clearly suggest an election date but account for unforeseeable events.

THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED THAT THE ASSOCIATED STUDENT BODY SENATE AMENDS THE ASB CONSTITUTION TO CLARIFY ELECTION DATES.
