 - c. Absent: Gianna Schuetz
- III. Report Executive Officers
 - a. President Barron Mayfeild
 - i. Everybody's Formal is coming up. Cabinet members will be required to work at least one hour at the event.
 - ii. Code and Constitution rewrite efforts starting next week. This will be a collaborative process between different branches of ASB.
 - b. Vice President Charlotte Shakelford
 - i. 'Submit your opinion to the ASB Senate' form is now up and live on the ASB website. Graphics will be created and sent out soon.
 - ii. We are trying to make the Senate Livestream more accessible for our audiences. Livestreams will be placed on hold until further accessibility updates have been made.
 - iii. The originally scheduled Formal Senate next week is changed to Informal Senate.
 - c. Attorney General Austin Fiala
 - i. We had a record voter turnout this season- 6443 students voted in Tuesday's Personality Elections.
 - ii. The results of the referendum vote on the Student Activities Fee: were now by 63.93%
 - iii. A total of 15 individuals won their respective offices Tuesday night and 6 candidates will move on to runoff elections
 - iv. The first historical Homecoming King election will continue and will conclude Thursday night. The University of Mississippi is the



first school in the SEC to have an elected Homecoming King position.

- v. Results for the runoff election are expected to be announced Thursday night at 7:05pm in front of the Lyceum
- d. Treasurer Gianna Schuetz
 - i. The Treasury Department reviewed 10 requests this week. 1 was denied, 3 were approved, and 6 were deferred for improper documentation.
 - ii. The Internal Budget is officially done and formatted- this will be presented to the Senate sometime in the near future
 - iii. In reference to the Student Activity Fee referendum vote- "For the future of ASB- yes we represent all students but we represent the GOOD of all students. Yes- students resoundingly voiced that they did not want this, which is completely fine! They did not want this to happen and I am extremely glad we got their opinion before moving forward. BUT if we have decided we are doing something for the good of students then we all need to commit- not just three people sharing graphics. I could definitely have done more- but this whole process has been extremely hurtful to me. I am extremely passionate about this resource and I do not feel like ASB or my fellow executive officers supported me in this."
- e. Judicial Chair Liza Boyer
 - i. Judicial Council has been assisting with elections violations hearing. Members of Judicial Council are currently on standby in case they are needed during the remainder of the campaign period.
 - ii. There are multiple upcoming cases in the following weeks, major and minor.
- f. Secretary Hannah Chauvin
 - i. There are multiple ASB directories which is causing a few issues in the line of communication. We only need the most updated directory that all Executive Officers have editing access to.
