Certified Senate candidates must appear before the ASB Senate for election proceedings which formally begin at 7 pm. We will convene in the ASB Senate Chamber, Union 124. Candidates for the open seat(s) will meet with Senate Parliamentarian Sara Austin Welch to discuss the order of events for the evening. Unofficial Transcripts: Unofficial transcripts can be printed through MyOleMiss, or provided by the Office of the Registrar. Freshmen do not need to provide a transcript, given they are in good academic standing.

Qualifications: For the office of Campus Senator, the following qualifications are required: Nominees shall be a currently enrolled freshman in good standing or an upper-class student with a minimum 2.75 GPA. **An individual may not serve as senator and also currently hold another office in the Associated Student Body.**

Election: Certified candidates will appear before the ASB Senate at 7:00 PM on Tuesday, January 30th, 2024. Each candidate will have 90 seconds to present their qualifications before the ASB Senate. Typically candidates will introduce themselves, state a short platform/ reason(s) why they are running, and any relevant personal attributes or previous experience. The present and voting Senators will then debate and elect one (1) individual for the one (1) Senator At-Large seat. After the vote, all candidates will be informed about the results of the election. The Vice President will then swear in the Senator(s)-elect!

Previous Senate Candidates: Please note that individuals that participated as a Senate candidate during previous Open Senate Seat Elections DO NOT need to complete this petition as they have already filed an approved petition with the Department of Justice. All former Open Senate candidates who were not elected will be contacted via email at the same time as the petitioning candidates in order to inform them that their candidacy has been certified.
