A BILL OF THE ASSOCIATED STUDENT BODY SENATE AMENDING ARTICLE XVII OF THE RULES OF THE UNIVERSITY OF MISSISSIPPI CAMPUS SENATE, WHICH CURRENTLY READS:

ARTICLE XVII

AMENDMENTS

Section 1: Amendments to these rules may be made by a two-thirds (2/3) vote of those members present and voting. There will be one meeting's notice of a change in the rules.

Section 2

Section 1: These rules may be amended by a majority vote of those members voting.

Any proposed amendment must be presented on the Senate floor at least one week before the Senate acts upon it.

WHEREAS, there has been confusion over the process to amend the Rules of the ASB Campus Senate;

WHEREAS, it should not be more difficult to change Senate Rules than it is to make laws;

WHEREAS, it should be clarified that an amendment will be voted on once after the senators have had time for consideration.

THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED THAT THE ASSOCIATED STUDENT BODY SENATE AMENDS ARTICLE XVII OF THE RULES OF THE UNIVERSITY OF MISSISSIPPI CAMPUS SENATE.
