A BILL OF THE ASSOCIATED STUDENT BODY SENATE TO AMEND THE ASSOCIATED STUDENT BODY CODE AND CONSTITUTION TO ADD THE POSITION(S) OF HOMECOMING KING TO THE PERSONALITY ELECTION BALLOT.

Section V, Subtitle A, Section 103,

E) Fall General Elections (Personality Elections)

- 1) The Fall General Election shall be conducted by the Deputy Attorney General of Elections for the election of Homecoming Queen, Miss Ole Miss, Mr. Ole Miss, ten (10) Campus Favorites, and four (4) Homecoming Maids, one (1) from each class.

- 2) Must have a minimum 3.0 GPA.
- 3) Must be a female.

B) Homecoming Queen and Homecoming King

- 1) Completed sixty (60) semester hours, twelve (12) hours of which shall have been completed at The University of Mississippi.
- 2) Must have a minimum 3.0 GPA.
- 3) Candidates for Homecoming Queen must identify as female and candidates for Homecoming King must identify as male.
