WHEREAS, Senator Amitin was in the School of Accountancy when elected to serve as an ASB Senator;

WHEREAS, Senator Amitin has since withdrawn from the School of Accountancy;

WHEREAS, Senator Amitin is committed to serving the School of Accountancy through her role as ASB Senator;
