A RESOLUTION OF THE ASSOCIATED STUDENT BODY SENATE TO REQUEST THE EXPANSION OF SUPPLEMENTAL INSTRUCTION PROGRAMS TO INCLUDE MORE SUBJECT AREAS.

WHEREAS, Supplemental Instruction (SI) programs are already prevalent in a multitude of departments at the University of Mississippi, including Spanish, Science, and Accounting;

WHEREAS, SI programs are currently restrained to courses which have class sizes over 100 (with the exception of Spanish Supplemental Instruction) and who have a 40% fail rate from the previous semester;

WHEREAS, SI programs have proven to bolster academic performance in the courses currently offered, with an average GPA increase of .52 for participating students;


WHEREAS, In order to strengthen academic excellence on campus, the University of Mississippi should expand the supplemental instruction (SI) programs to include more courses where the Center for Teaching Excellence sees fit;


