WHEREAS, access to voting is in the best interests of the students of the University of Mississippi concerning the preparation for the next stage of community engagement; AND WHEREAS, this resolution will be sent to the office of the Chancellor and the office of the Provost for immediate consideration;

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT THE ASSOCIATED STUDENT BODY SENATE ENDORSES THE PROPOSED LEGISLATION THAT WOULD REQUIRE VOTING PLACES ON COLLEGE CAMPUS AND ONLINE REGISTRATION FOR FIRST-TIME VOTERS
